



Payment Policy

*"(Believers are those) who are faithful to their trusts and to their commitments."
(23:8)*

"O Believers: Honour your contracts" (5:1)

Aims

- To have a simple, transparent and prompt payment service.
- To consider the financial difficulties of some parents.
- To ensure all staff are paid promptly.
- To cover costs of FLA resources and other expenses.

Payments

1. The fees of S1-S7 are calculated at £2 per day/ £10 a week which covers the cost of classes and sports. Pre-FLA, GCSE Arabic and GCSE Islamic Studies fees are calculated at £2.50 per session, as those classes cost more to maintain and prepare, and FLA WE School fees are calculated at £3.00 per session, as those classes cost more to maintain and prepare and have smaller groups.
2. The fees are payable by bank transfer; in exceptional cases by cash or cheques.
3. Cheques should be made payable to Yusuf Youth Initiative.
4. Payments should be made promptly at the start of every term (4 terms per school year). If two weeks of a new term have passed and payment has not been made, a 10 pound fine per child shall be added to the due payment.

5. Any outstanding fees should be paid immediately. If two months into the term parents have not paid the fees, the pupil will be excluded from FLA pupils list and not accepted to attend the class any more.
6. Payments can be made for the full term or full year.

Refunds

1. Refunds are due only where we are forced to cancel a class e.g. in case of bad weather.
2. There are no refunds for pupil absence including a planned/unplanned and authorised/unauthorised absence such as illness and/or a medical appointment etc.
3. This also includes family holidays. Pupils on family holidays are required to pay fees for the length of period they are off. This is to cover cost of staff salaries and other FLA expenses.
4. Any refunds will be deducted off future fees.

Discounts

1. If there are two or more siblings attending FLA, a 10% discount is available for the second child and a 20% discount for a third child (if they attend FLA classes 4h or more per week).
2. Discounts may also be available for those in financial difficulty. This can be discussed with the FLA Co-ordinator / Head Teacher.

Other costs

1. The cost of trips or other external activities is not covered by FLA fees.
2. Parents may be required to pay an additional amount for other activities or personal study materials.
3. Where possible, FLA will endeavour to partially cover the cost of any trip/external activity.
